PURPOSE

To honor exemplary accomplishments performed by a registered sanitarian in the field of environmental health.

CRITERIA AND QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Registered Sanitarian.
- 2. Demonstration of interest and accomplishment in the field of environmental health.
- 3. Represents an exemplary level of professionalism.
- 4. Nominee for the award must be a person whose primary source of income is derived from the practice of the sanitarian profession.
- 5. Must be a LEHA member in good standing.
- 6. Award shall be issued only once per individual.

NOMINATIONS

- 1. Must be submitted by a LEHA member in good standing.
- 2. Must be submitted to the Chairman of the Awards Committee prior to the last Board of Directors meeting of the year.
- 3. In the absence of nominations, the Board may nominate and conform without the limitations.
- 4. In any event the Board may elect not to confer the award.

SELECTIONS

- 1. Nominee's criteria and qualifications to be considered cumulatively by the Awards Committee.
- 2. The Awards Committee's first choice including documentation to be submitted to the Board of Directors at the last board meeting of the year for consideration and concurrence or rejection.

AWARD

In the form of an engraved plaque the cost of which to be derived from the Treasury of LEHA and to be presented at the Annual Educational Conference.
