FRANK L. DAUTRIEL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND UNDERGRADUATE AWARD AMOUNT \$1000

PURPOSE

To encourage an outstanding undergraduate student of environmental health, environmental science, environmental engineering, or public health by direct monetary support and thus enhance the respectability of the Louisiana Environmental Health Association (LEHA) by its recognition of the environmental health profession.

CRITERIA & QUALIFICATIONS

Nominees must:

- 1. Be enrolled as a full time student in an environmental health, environmental science, environmental engineering, or public health related degree program at an accredited university;
- 2. Be a Louisiana resident;
- 3. Have maintained an overall 2.75 or higher on a 4.0 grade point rating system and have a record of good conduct supported by official transcript;
- 4. Nominee must submit two letters of recommendation, along with his/her college transcript from said accredited college, or from any LEHA member in good standing;
- 5. Demonstrate a need for said scholarship; and
- 6. Present evidence of additional work experience in any environmental health, environmental science, environmental engineering, or public health discipline and demonstrate his/her interest in continued work in the field (i.e. membership in any environmental organization such as student membership in the National Environmental Health Association).

NOMINATIONS

Must be submitted to the Chairman of the Awards Committee by February 1 or as may be otherwise authorized by the Board.

SELECTION

Recommendation by the LEHA Awards Committee after review of all nominations received shall be submitted with documentation to the Board of Directors at the last board meeting of the year.

AWARD

One \$1000 scholarship in the form of a check to be presented to the Awardee at the LEHA Annual Educational Conference.
